WORKERS MOBILISE AGAINST RACIST HATE!

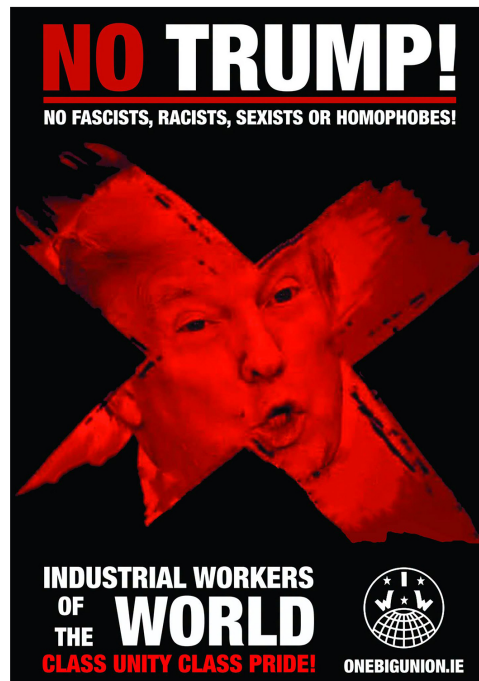
So word is out that Trump is planning yet another visit to Ireland, which is expected to begin next month around September 12th 2026.

The scheduled visit to Dublin will also include a trip to the Irish Open at his golf resort in Doonbeg, Co Clare, which runs from September 9th to 13th.

Already, plans are afoot by anti war, anti racist, feminist and LGBTIQ+ activists, as well as the wider community to reject such a visit, and what Trump and his regime represents.

In doing so, we must ensure our opposition to 'the great and the good' here in Ireland, who seek to entertain this fascist theatre.

The Industrial Workers of the World echo calls to actively oppose this fascist charade that will see our communities militarised and isolated at the cost millions to entertain this circus.



The Trump visit comes at a time when our Health Services and our Housing system is at a critical crisis point.

At a time when services are being reduced in favour of further privatisation, housing waiting lists spiralling out of control and affordability beyond the reach of workers and their families, while bosses feed off their profits.

As revolutionary syndicalists, we continue to call upon every worker to unionise. As a union, the IWW call upon the labour movement to actively mobilise, and encourage workers to take part in organised actions in opposition to Trumps fascist road show in Ireland.

SOCIAL REVOLUTION COMMEMORATED ON 90TH ANNIVERSARY

One of the largest online talks in recent times took place in July to commemorate the 90th anniversary of the Spanish Social Revolution.

The online event had been organised jointly by the CNT-E and IWW WISE-RA as part of a presentation on the meaning of the Social Revolution that broke out in Spain.

The event was created to remember that the revolution came after the defeat of the fascist coup d'état by the working people. Subsequently the urban proletariat took over factories and workshops, organised popular canteens and workers' militias that went on to conquer the cities held by criminal fascists.

In the countryside, a large-scale revolution erupted, spreading across much of the Republican territory in Spain.

In total, about three million people took part in this revolution and they proved that the people are capable of managing their own affairs without the need for bosses.

The successful online presentation and discussion has been brought to us by a collaboration with the Confederación Na-



cional del Trabajo (National Confederation of Labour) - CNT and the International Confederation of Labour (Confederación Internacional del Trabajo ICL-CIT), the international organisation to which both revolutionary unions belong.

A spokesperson for the IWW and WISE-RA International Secretary, who chaired the presentation, spoke afterwards, saying "I would like to take this opportunity to thank

our comrade, Miguel Gómez, a militant of the CNT in Catalonia, in presenting the talk.

"It really was a fantastic opportunity to have such a noted labour historian to join with us in marking and celebrating the occasion of the 90th Anniversary of the Spanish Social Revolution.

"Miguel is also the researcher and author of highly accredited book 'The CNT and the New Economy'.

"He laid out extremely well, for those in attendance, the atmosphere within the Spanish State prior to the revolution, to examining the numerous achievements, the challenges and lessons of revolutionary Spain."

The discussion came to a close following an informative questions and answers session.

Without doubt what took place was a successful online educational event, something that could be built upon in the coming months.

IWW Demand That Rights For Trans Workers Be Defended

On the 13th July, thousands gathered with Trans & Intersex pride in their annual march.

This year's march was under the slogan "death, death to the NGS" - a demand to desegregate the health service and make trans healthcare a consent based service.

This came about after it was reported that the national gender service was closing its waitlist to new referrals - a list which already had over 2,000 people and had wait times of years - Ireland has been reported as ranking as one of the worst counties for trans healthcare in the EU.

Other issues raised included the housing

crisis, extortionate rents, worker's rights, and the genocide carried out by Israel.

The show of solidarity on the march was strong and reassuring, but there needs to be a serious movement that protects the rights of trans workers, who still face discrimination in wages, workplace and health and housing access.

Attempts to deny the trans rights movement's place in the wider worker's struggle should not be tolerated when trans workers have been among the strongest allies of worker's rights in Ireland - trans and intersex pride demonstrated that exact solidarity, and it is our strength.

The queer and trans struggle is an interna-



tional workers struggle after all.
